Dear Bryan Cleaver,

This letter is in response to Coastal Valleys Emergency Medical Service (EMS) Agency's 2025 EMS, Trauma, St-Elevation Myocardial Infarction (STEMI), Stroke, and Quality Improvement (QI) plan submissions to Emergency Medical Service Authority (EMSA).

EMSA has reviewed the EMS plan based on compliance with statutes, regulations, and case law. It has been determined that the plan meets all EMS system components identified in Health and Safety Code (HSC) § 1797.103 and is approved for implementation pursuant to HSC § 1797.105(b).

EMSA has also reviewed the Trauma, STEMI, Stroke, and QI plans based on compliance with Chapters 6.1, 6.2, 6.3, and 10 of the California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Division 9, and has been approved for implementation.

Based on the transportation documentation provided, please find the EMS area/subarea status below, compiled by EMSA:

Coastal Valleys 2025 EMS Area and Subareas**Mendocino County**

Zone 1. Emergency ambulance services not expressly identified in the LEMSA's EMS plan, including related submissions, are emergency ambulance response to 911 calls, emergency ambulance response to 10-digit calls, emergency ambulance transport, interfacility transports, and standby services, are outside the scope of this approval and not subject to approved exclusivity. These referenced EMS services are non-exclusive.

Zone 2. Emergency ambulance services not expressly identified in the LEMSA's EMS plan, including related submissions, are emergency ambulance response to 911 calls, emergency ambulance response to 10-digit calls, emergency ambulance transport, interfacility transports, and standby services, are outside the scope of this approval and not subject to approved exclusivity. These referenced EMS services are non-exclusive.

Zone 3. Emergency ambulance services not expressly identified in the LEMSA's EMS plan, including related submissions, are emergency ambulance response to 911 calls, emergency

ambulance response to 10-digit calls, emergency ambulance transport, interfacility transports, and standby services, are outside the scope of this approval and not subject to approved exclusivity. These referenced EMS services are non-exclusive.

Sonoma County

EOA 1. The operating area is approved for the exclusive provision of emergency ambulance services only to the extent such services were included within the competitive process. Based on the materials submitted, the competitive process encompassed: (1) emergency ambulance response to 9-1-1 calls; (2) emergency ambulance response to 10-digit calls; (3) emergency ambulance transport from the scene of an emergency to a general acute care hospital at the ALS, including BLS, level of care; and (4) emergency standby and standby services with transport.

Emergency ambulance services not expressly included within the competitive process, including non-emergency interfacility transports, are outside the scope of this approval and are not subject to the approved exclusivity.

EOA 2. The operating area is approved for the exclusive provision of emergency ambulance services pursuant to HSC § 1797.224 based on the continued use of an existing provider. Based on the information submitted to and reviewed by EMSA, the approved exclusivity encompasses: (1) emergency ambulance response to 9-1-1 calls; (2) emergency ambulance response to 10-digit calls; and (3) emergency ambulance transport from the scene of an emergency to a general acute care hospital at the ALS, including BLS, level of care.

Emergency ambulance services not expressly identified in the LEMSA's EMS plans, including related submissions, including critical care transport, and other uses of emergency ambulances such as standby services, are outside the scope of this approval and are not subject to the approved exclusivity.

Cloverdale Ambulance Healthcare District. Emergency ambulance services not expressly identified in the LEMSA's EMS plan, including related submissions, are emergency ambulance response to 911 calls, emergency ambulance response to 10-digit calls, emergency ambulance transport, interfacility transports, and standby services, are outside the scope of this approval and not subject to approved exclusivity. These referenced EMS services are non-exclusive.

Coast Life Support District. Emergency ambulance services not expressly identified in the LEMSA's EMS plan, including related submissions, are emergency ambulance response to 911 calls, emergency ambulance response to 10-digit calls, emergency ambulance transport, interfacility transports, and standby services, are outside the scope of this approval and not subject to approved exclusivity. These referenced EMS services are non-exclusive.

Petaluma Fire Department Ambulance Service Zone. Emergency ambulance services not expressly identified in the LEMSA's EMS plan, including related submissions, are emergency ambulance response to 911 calls, emergency ambulance response to 10-digit calls, emergency ambulance transport, interfacility transports, and standby services, are outside the scope of this approval and not subject to approved exclusivity. These referenced EMS services are non-exclusive.

Closest ALS-Sonoma Raceway Ambulance Service Zone Emergency ambulance services not

expressly identified in the LEMSA's EMS plan, including related submissions, are emergency ambulance response to 911 calls, emergency ambulance response to 10-digit calls, emergency ambulance transport, interfacility transports, and standby services, are outside the scope of this approval and not subject to approved exclusivity. These referenced EMS services are non-exclusive.

Sonoma Valley Fire and Rescue District Authority Ambulance Service Zone. Emergency ambulance services not expressly identified in the LEMSA's EMS plan, including related submissions, are emergency ambulance response to 911 calls, emergency ambulance response to 10-digit calls, emergency ambulance transport, interfacility transports, and standby services, are outside the scope of this approval and not subject to approved exclusivity. These referenced EMS services are non-exclusive.

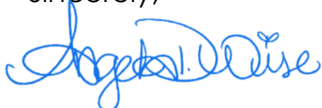
Sonoma County Fire District Ambulance Service Zone 1. Emergency ambulance services not expressly identified in the LEMSA's EMS plan, including related submissions, are emergency ambulance response to 911 calls, emergency ambulance response to 10-digit calls, emergency ambulance transport, interfacility transports, and standby services, are outside the scope of this approval and not subject to approved exclusivity. These referenced EMS services are non-exclusive.

Sonoma County Fire District Ambulance Service Zone 2. Emergency ambulance services not expressly identified in the LEMSA's EMS plan, including related submissions, are emergency ambulance response to 911 calls, emergency ambulance response to 10-digit calls, emergency ambulance transport, interfacility transports, and standby services, are outside the scope of this approval and not subject to approved exclusivity. These referenced EMS services are non-exclusive.

Per HSC § 1797.254, local EMS agencies must annually submit EMS plans to EMSA. Coastal Valleys County EMS Agency will only be considered current if an EMS plan is submitted each year. Concurrently with the EMS plan, please submit an annual Trauma, STEMI, Stroke, and QI plan.
